Interpretation of Competition Subjects

Life on the Water - this title refers to any **Life on** the water e.g. animals, birds, people such as surfers, boaters or swimmers. It does not include just scenery with water in it such as a beach or riverside scene.

Shallow Depth of Field - images should demonstrate differential focus either in the foreground or background with a definite focal point.

Metal - this can be a creative or straight forward image containing a metal object, or demonstrate the reflective properties of metal or painted metal surfaces.

A Touch of Red - any image which contains a single element or small elements of red colour within the picture as a whole.

Fauna - the main subject should be animal, bird, insect or reptile life. Fauna does not include human life as the main element in the image.

Celebration - this subject can include people, animals or objects at any occasion associated with the word 'Celebration'.

Patterns in Nature - this title refers to subjects shown in their **natural environment** to demonstrate a pattern of either form and/or colour.
